Oral Presentations

The time allocated for a presentation is 10 minutes, with a further 5 minutes allowed for discussion/questions.

Please email your presentations in PowerPoint or PDF format to claire.vanwyk@uct.ac.za by 19.00 on Sunday 5th March.

As a guide, your presentation should include the following:

- A title slide – name, degree, institution and title of research.
- Do not put too much text on a slide – you want the audience to listen to you and not to be reading your slides.
- A great rule of thumb is the 6 x 6 rule: When using bullets, aim for slides with 6 bullets or less per slide, and 6 words or less per bullet.

Poster Presentations

Please arrive at **08.30** to set-up your poster on one of the boards provided or bring it to the ACDI office this week if you can and we will put it up for you. We will provide tacks.

Poster presentations will take place during the tea/coffee breaks, and over lunch. Poster presenters are requested to take their breaks nearby their posters, so that they can answer questions should they see someone at their stand. Judges will be reviewing posters throughout the day.

Prize Giving

Oral and Poster presentations will be judged on a rubric which includes organization, quality of information, and diagrams and illustrations.

Second Prize Oral Presentations: R1 000 Exclusive Books voucher.

First Prize Poster Presentations: R2 000 cash prize (collected at the ACDI offices).

Second Prize Poster Presentations: R1 000 Exclusive Book Voucher.
